Understanding God's Goodness and Mercy

Scriptures: Psalm 23:6 Psalm 107:7 Romans 8:28 Exodus 34:6 Hebrews 13:5 Psalm 51:1 Psalm 145:9 Galatians 5:22 1 Chronicles 16:34



In Psalm 23:6 we read "*surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the lord forever*". What a wonderful thought this is - God's goodness and mercy shall be with us every day of our lives. There is a song related to Psalm 23:6 and the words of this songs are as follows:

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days, all the days of my life, Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days, all the days of my life. And I shall dwell in the house of the lord forever.

I shall feast at a table spread for me,

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life.

Again, what an amazing thought, that all the days of our lives God's goodness and mercy are with us. In one year, there are 365 days and in 10 years that would mean 3650 days. I have been a Christian now for over 30 years, that is an incredible 10,950 days that God's goodness and mercy have been with me.

What then is Gods' goodness and Mercy?

Once again in 1 Chronicles 16:34 we are reminded that his goodness, loving kindness, and mercy will follow us all the days of your lives. "*Give thanks to the lord for he is good, and his mercy endures forever* (1 Chronicles 16:34). As Christians we can be assured of the Lord's grace, care, goodness and mercy each day that God has planned for us. God's unfailing love, goodness, and mercy will be sufficient for what each day holds (Exodus 34:6, I Chronicles 16:34, Psalm 23:6, Psalm107 :1).
