I read these words this afternoon: "if God puts a Goliath in front of you, it's because He knows there is a David inside you", and it has made me stop and think. David is called a man after God's own heart; David was God's chosen King to rule over all twelve tribes of Israel; David was the one who saw his own frailty and knew, so often, that he owed all his victories, all his peace to God alone.
